Directions to Flint Creek Farm: Flint Creek Farm is located off of Hwy 412 approx. 8 miles West of the Arkansas border and Siloam Springs, AR.

If you are coming from Tulsa, go East on I-44 to Hwy 412 East. After crossing the Grand River, get onto the Cherokee Turnpike. Stay on the Cherokee Turnpike until it ends and you will be on 412 East again. Immediately get into the left lane and turn left on the paved road between the Phillips 66 station and the water slide. (If you cross over Flint Creek, you have gone too far.) Follow the paved road for 1.8 mi, then turn right onto the gravel road CR 558 before you start up the hill. Follow the gravel road for 1 mi and you will see the front gate (green pipe fence) on the right- hand side. Turn right and follow the farm road down to the parking area.
